# Barbara Frey's Triple Chocolate Cake

1/4 cup oil

1 box Devil's Food Cake Mix

1 box instant chocolate pudding mix

1 cup chocolate chips

1 1/2 cups water

2 eggs


Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Pour the oil into a 9 x 13 pan and spread evenly. Add remaining ingredients. Mix with a fork or spoon until well blended. Scrape sides well. Bake for 35-45 minutes.

#### Variations:

-Add 1 tablespoon instant coffee granules.

-Drain a can of dark sweet cherries into a measuring cup and add enough water to equal 1 1/2 cups. Add instead of plain water. Scatter cherries on top of mixed cake. They will be mostly covered when the cake is finished.

-Add 1 cup of chopped nuts.
